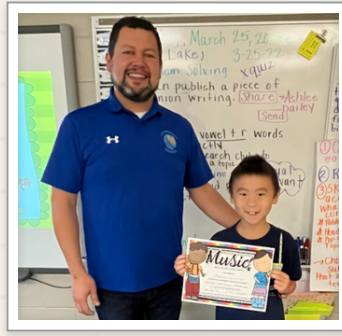
IT'S MUSIC IN OUR SCHOOLS MONTH!

These students were presented with a very special certificate from Mr. Candillo. We are so proud them. Thank you for sharing your musical talents with us!



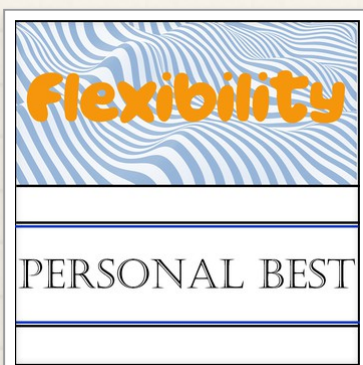

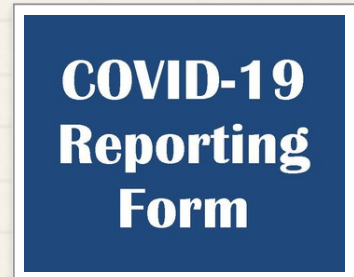

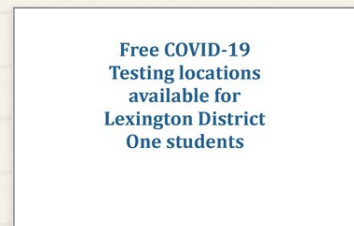
