Board approves new PES assistant principal

LEXINGTON, S.C. — During the June 25, 2019 Board Meeting of the Lexington County School District One Board of Trustees, the board approved the promotion of M. Casey Davis for the position of assistant principal at Pelion Elementary School.

A fifth grade teacher at Meadow Glen Elementary since 2015, Davis also serves on the school's Expeditionary Learning Leadership Team by modeling best practices, providing professional development on classroom management practices and protocols, and planning and leading grade-level weekly team meetings.

Davis began her teaching career at Lewisville Elementary School in 2008, in Chester County School District. After two years, she taught at Chester Park Center for Literacy Through Technology for a year before moving to Rosewood International Elementary School in 2011.

Career awards include 2013–2014 Teacher of the Year and York County School District Three Distinguished Climber award for collaboration.

She received her Bachelor of Science in elementary education and Master of Education in curriculum and instruction from Winthrop University, as well as a Master of Education in educational leadership from the University of South Carolina. Davis completed the Lexington District One Aspiring Administrators Cohort in May 2019.

Davis is an active member of the Kappa Delta Pi Educational Honor Society and Palmetto State Teachers Association, in addition to serving as a mentor for Columbia College students studying education.
